**Concern:** Noisy engine cooling fan bearing /damaged drive belts.

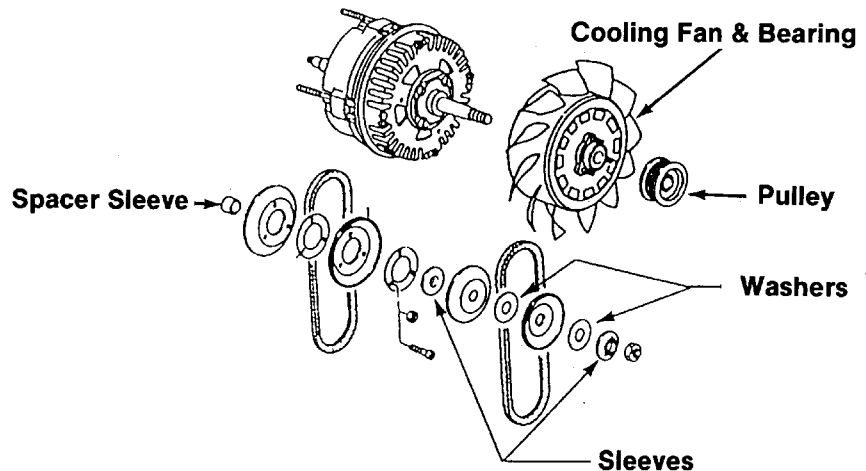
